Match background

Fresh from their biggest European victory, Leipzig welcome Group A winners Manchester City to Germany looking to secure third place in the section.

- The Bundesliga club were 5-0 winners at Club Brugge on Matchday 5, the joint biggest margin of victory in this season's UEFA Champions League, to move level with the Belgian club on four points, although Leipzig hold the head-to-head advantage. That means they will qualify for the UEFA Europa League if they match or better Club Brugge's result at Paris Saint-Germain.
- City also triumphed on Matchday 5, a 2-1 win at home to Paris – their tenth successive home victory in the competition – securing first place in Group A ahead of the French club; the English champions have won four of their five games in the section.
- The first of those was a 6-3 defeat of Leipzig at the City of Manchester Stadium on Matchday 1 despite Christopher Nkunku's hat-trick for the visitors; the midfielder therefore became only the fourth player to end a UEFA Champions League match on the losing side after scoring three times. The win featured first European goals from Nathan Aké (16) and Jack Grealish (56) plus a Nordin Mukiele own goal (28), a Riyad Mahrez penalty (45+2) and late strikes from João Cancelo (75) and Gabriel Jesus (85).
- Leipzig will be under new management for this match having parted company with coach Jesse Marsch on Sunday; assistant Achim Beierlorzer will take temporary charge.

Form guide

Leipzig

- This is Leipzig's fourth UEFA Champions League group campaign, all in the last five seasons.
- Semi-finalists in 2019/20, a team coached by Julian Nagelsmann again reached the knockout stages last season, beating Manchester United 3-2 on Matchday 6 to secure second place in Group H behind Paris.
- Another English side proved too strong in the round of 16, however, Liverpool winning each leg 2-0 with both games played in Budapest.
- Nagelsmann left to succeed Germany-bound Hansi Flick as Bayern coach in the summer, Salzburg's Jesse Marsch taking his place at Leipzig.
- Leipzig have won 13 of their 29 UEFA Champions League fixtures (D4 L12) but have lost eight of the last 14, the Matchday 4 draw against Paris ending a five-game losing streak. Victory in Bruges last time out was their first in seven games (D1 L5).
- Leipzig have both scored and conceded 13 goals; that 26-goal aggregate after five matchdays is the highest in this season's group stage – one more than Manchester City (F17 A8).
- The German side had won four successive European games in Leipzig before losing 2-1 to Club Brugge on Matchday 2; that is their only defeat on their own ground since a 2-0 loss to Lyon on Matchday 2 in 2019/20 (W5 D2).
- Second in the Bundesliga in 2020/21, their joint highest finish, this is Leipzig's fifth European campaign. In 2017/18 they became the first team to make their European debut in the UEFA Champions League group stage.
- Nkunku's Matchday 1 hat-trick at City made him the fourth player to score three goals in a UEFA Champions League defeat, after Ronaldo (Manchester United 4-3 Real Madrid in 2002/03), Gareth Bale (Tottenham 3-4 Inter, 2010/11) and İrfan Can Kahveci (İstanbul Başakşehir 3-4 Leipzig, 2020/21).
- Leipzig have won both home games against English visitors; before beating City's neighbours Manchester United 3-2 at home on Matchday 6 last season to reach the round of 16, they were 3-0 victors against Tottenham in the 2019/20 round of 16 second leg (4-0 aggregate).
- Defeat in Manchester on Matchday 1 made it three successive losses to English clubs and four defeats in the last five, the exception that victory against United.

Manchester City

- In 2020/21 City ended a run of three successive quarter-final eliminations by going all the way to the UEFA Champions League final only to lose 1-0 to Chelsea at Porto's Estádio do Dragão on 29 May.
- City beat Borussia Mönchengladbach (2-0 a, 2-0 h), Borussia Dortmund (2-1 h, 2-1 a) and Paris (2-1 a, 2-0 h) en route to the final. They had finished first in Group C with 16 points, keeping five clean sheets and conceding only one goal – equalling the UEFA Champions League group stage record.
- City have already conceded eight goals in the 2021/22 UEFA Champions League, three more than in their 13 games in last season's competition, and have yet to keep a clean sheet.

- Champions of England for the seventh time in 2020/21, their third title in four seasons, City also claimed the English League Cup for the fourth season in a row and the eighth overall, equalling Liverpool's competition record.
- This is the Cityzens' 11th UEFA Champions League campaign; they have been involved in the group stage every season since 2011/12 and have now reached the round of 16 in nine successive campaigns.
- Guardiola's team have won 13 of their last 19 away European matches (D3 L3). The last two defeats before the loss in Paris on Matchday 2 had both come in England; the previous away game they had lost abroad was at Shakhtar Donetsk (1-2) on Matchday 6 of the 2017/18 UEFA Champions League.
- City took on German opponents in both the round of 16 and quarter-final last season, winning all four games. The 2-1 win at Dortmund in the quarter-final second leg was the Cityzens' third successive victory in Germany; City lost six of their first eight away games against German clubs (W2) but are unbeaten in the last five (W4 D1).
- A 1-1 draw in Mönchengladbach in November 2016 is the only one of City's last 14 matches against German clubs they have failed to win, stretching back to a 1-0 loss at Bayern in September 2014.

- Angeliño was a Manchester City player between July 2012 and 2021, when he completed a permanent move to Leipzig having been on loan at the club since January 2020. He made only six Premier League appearances for City, all in the first half of that 2019/20 campaign.

- Pep Guardiola was Bayern coach between 2013 and 2016, winning the Bundesliga in all three of his seasons in charge. He never faced Leipzig.
- Torres scored a hat-trick in Spain's 6-0 win against Germany in the group stage of the UEFA Nations League on 17 November 2020.
- Raheem Sterling opened the scoring in England's 2-0 win against Germany in the UEFA EURO 2020 round of 16 at Wembley on 29 June; Jack Grealish provided the assist for the second goal.
- John Stones scored past Gulácsi in a 2022 FIFA World Cup qualifier between England and Hungary at Wembley on 12 October (1-1). Four other City players started the game for the home team – Grealish, Sterling, Kyle Walker and Phil Foden.

Latest news

Leipzig

- Josep Martínez, Solomon Bonnah and Hugo Novoa all made their first appearances in UEFA club competition on Matchday 5.
- Leipzig have won only eight of their 21 games this season in all competitions, losing nine including a 3-1 defeat against Bayer Leverkusen on 28 November and Friday's 2-1 reverse at Union Berlin.
- On Sunday the club parted company with coach Jesse Marsch after just over five months in charge; assistant Achim Beierlorzer will be in charge against City.
- That home loss to Leverkusen was Leipzig's second in the Bundesliga this season, after a 4-1 defeat against Bayern on 11 September. They have won the other five league games at home.
- After seven league games without defeat, Leipzig have lost the last three.
- Christopher Nkunku has 13 goals in his last 16 Leipzig games including one at Union on Friday.
- After winning 1-0 at fourth-tier Babelsberg in the German Cup second round on 26 October, Leipzig will be at home to 2. Bundesliga side Hansa Rostock in the last 16 on 19 January.
- Substitute Novoa scored with his first touch in his first professional game for Leipzig against Greuther Fürth on 23

October, becoming Leipzig's youngest ever Bundesliga scorer aged 18 years 272 days.

- Dani Olmo has missed the last four Leipzig games because of a thigh injury.
- Coach Jesse Marsch, assistant Achim Beierlorzer and Willi Orbán and Novoa have all been absent due to illness. Péter Gulácsi returned from illness at Union Berlin, as did substitute Mohamed Simakan.
- Yussuf Poulsen suffered a calf injury in Denmark's 3-1 home win against the Faroe Islands on 12 November and has not played since; he has also been ill.
- Marcel Halstenberg is yet to feature this season because of an ankle injury and has also been suffering with knee problems that needed surgery in mid-October.
- Marcelo Saracchi, who was left out of Leipzig's UEFA Champions League squad, has been sidelined since 23 July due to a knee injury.

Manchester City

- City have lost only two of their last 21 games in all competitions (W16 D3), the defeat at Paris on Matchday 2 and a 2-0 loss at home to Crystal Palace in the Premier League on 30 October.
- City won 3-1 at Watford on Saturday, Bernardo Silva scoring twice. The Portugal midfielder has seven goals in 14 Premier League games in 2021/22, equalling his best return for City from 36 matches in 2018/19, and has six in his last eight league appearances – one more than in his previous 61 matches.
- Raheem Sterling opened the scoring at Watford, his fourth goal in his last six City games.
- The win at Watford was Kyle Walker's 100th Premier League victory for City; having also achieved a century of league wins with Tottenham (102), he is only the third player to feature in 100 Premier League victories for two clubs, after Phil Neville (Manchester United and Everton) and Ashley Cole (Arsenal and Chelsea).
- The English champions were 2-1 winners at Aston Villa on 1 December, Rúben Dias opening the scoring with his first goal since 27 February before Bernardo Silva's winner.
- The win at Villa was Pep Guardiola's 150th Premier League victory; he is only the fourth manager to reach that total with one club, and in his 204th game the fastest, beating Sir Alex Ferguson's previous record of 247 matches.
- Guardiola's side have failed to score in six of their 23 games in 2021/22, as many as in their previous 65 matches.
- City have kept nine clean sheets in their 23 games in all competitions this season. They have conceded only nine Premier League goals in their 15 matches.
- City, who have won the League Cup in each of the last four seasons, were eliminated from this season's competition in the last 16 at West Ham on 27 October, losing 5-3 on penalties after a goalless draw. Phil Foden missed City's first kick, the only player not to convert from the spot.
- It was the first League Cup tie City had lost since a 1-0 defeat at neighbours Manchester United, also in the last 16, on 26 October 2016.
- City lost 1-0 to Leicester City in the FA Community Shield at Wembley on 7 August – the seventh time they had been beaten in the match, on their 13th appearance.
- A 1-0 win at Chelsea on 25 September was Guardiola's 221st victory in all competitions as City manager, setting a new club record ahead of Les McDowall (220 wins, 1950–63).
- City's 55 goals this season have been scored by 20 different players.
- Fernandinho got the winner in a 2-1 victory against West Ham on 28 November (2-1), his first Premier League goal since 20 October 2018.
- Ferran Torres has not played since suffering a fractured foot in Spain's 2-1 defeat by France in the UEFA Nations League final on 10 October.
- Kevin De Bruyne returned as a substitute on Saturday, his first appearance since 16 November due to illness.
- John Stones, Walker and İlkay Gündoğan all missed the win at Villa due to injury; Walker and Gündoğan started at Watford, when Stones was an unused replacement.
- Jack Grealish returned as a substitute at former club Villa having not played since coming on in England's 5-0 win against Albania on 12 November while Foden was an unused substitute having made his last appearance on 21 November. Both started at Watford.
- Dias was named Defender of the Season for the 2020/21 UEFA Champions League on 26 August.
- Riyad Mahrez has been nominated for the FIFA Puskás Award, which recognises the Best Goal of the Year, for his strike for Algeria against Zimbabwe on 16 November 2020.

- De Bruyne finished eighth in the 2021 Ballon d'Or vote, with Sterling 15th, Mahrez 20th, Foden 25th and Dias joint 26th.
