Match background

LOSC Lille's second group stage campaign in three seasons kicks off against a Wolfsburg side featuring at this stage for the first time since 2015.

- The French champions, who are joined by Seville and Salzburg in Group G, are aiming to improve on their 2019/20 campaign when they picked up a single point from their six fixtures. Indeed, LOSC have progressed to the knockout stages only once in six previous attempts, while Wolfsburg got as far as the quarter-finals in that 2015/16 campaign.

Previous meetings

- The sides were paired together in the 2014/15 UEFA Europa League group stage. The drama in the first game in Germany was saved for the final 15 minutes, Divock Origi's penalty giving visitors LOSC a 77th-minute advantage that was cancelled out five minutes later by Kevin De Bruyne.
- Wolfsburg were 3-0 victors in the reverse fixture in northern France thanks to goals from Vieirinha (45+1) and Ricardo Rodríguez (65, 89pen).
- That Matchday 6 win at LOSC took Wolfsburg into the round of 32 as section runners-up behind Everton, leaving their French opponents bottom of the group.

Form guide

LOSC

- This is LOSC's seventh UEFA Champions League group stage campaign, but just their second in the past nine seasons.
- Les Dogues' last appearance came in 2019/20, when they finished bottom of a section that also included Valencia, Chelsea and Ajax. LOSC lost five of their six games, the exception a 1-1 draw at home to Valencia on Matchday 3.
- Only one of those previous six campaigns has extended into the knockout phase, in 2006/07 when they lost 1-0 home and away against Manchester United in the round of 16.
- In 2020/21, LOSC's European campaign began in the UEFA Europa League group stage, where they finished second in their section behind AC Milan on 11 points, recording a notable 3-0 away win against the Rossoneri to help them finish above Sparta Praha and Celtic.
- LOSC's campaign was ended by Ajax in the round of 32, the Amsterdam club winning 2-1 in both France and the Netherlands.
- LOSC claimed their fourth Ligue 1 title, and first since 2010/11, last season, finishing a point clear of Paris Saint-Germain. Their tally of 83 points was the highest in the club's history; LOSC suffered only three league defeats all season.
- The coach who oversaw that title triumph, Christophe Galtier, departed for Nice in the summer after four years in charge; former Guingamp and Bordeaux boss Jocelyn Gourvennec replaced him.
- The 2014 games with Wolfsburg were LOSC's last against a Bundesliga club. They have won just one of their nine matches with German teams (D3 L5), a 1-0 victory against Stuttgart in the first leg of a 2002 UEFA Intertoto Cup final (1-2 agg). At home it is W1 D1 L2, with defeats in the last two.

Wolfsburg

- Wolfsburg are making their third group stage appearance, after 2009/10 – when they failed to progress to the round of 16 – and 2015/16, when they reached the quarter-finals.
- The Wolves were first in their section six years ago, collecting 12 points from a group that also included Manchester United, PSV Eindhoven and CSKA Moskva. They beat Gent in the round of 16 (3-2 a, 1-0 h) before being thwarted by eventual winners Real Madrid in the last eight (2-0 h, 0-3 a).
- Wolfsburg have since featured in the UEFA Europa League twice; they were eliminated by Shakhtar Donetsk in the 2019/20 round of 16 (1-2 h, 0-3 a).
- In 2020/21, the German club were 4-0 winners at Albania's Kukësi in the one-off second qualifying round before a 2-0 home victory against Desna Chernihiv; they then lost 2-1 at AEK Athens in their play-off.
- Wolfsburg were fourth in the 2020/21 Bundesliga, their highest finish since ending as runners-up in 2014/15.
- The Wolves last faced French opponents in the 2019/20 UEFA Europa League group stage, beating St-Étienne 1-0 at home after a 1-1 draw in France. That 2014 win at LOSC is their only victory in their seven games in France (D3 L3).

• The French champions failed to win any of their first three league games of the season, drawing at Metz (3-3) and St-Étienne (1-1) either side of a 4-0 home loss against Christophe Galtier's Nice on 14 August; Galtier had guided LOSC to the Ligue 1 title in 2020/21.

• Les Dogues picked up their first league victory on 29 August, beating Montpellier 2-1 at home.

• LOSC were also beaten on Friday, however, going down 2-1 at Lorient. Their total of five points after five games in six less than at the same stage of last season.

• LOSC's 11 goals conceded in their first five games is the highest total for a French champion since St-Étienne in 1964/65.

• LOSC had ended Paris Saint-Germain's run of eight successive French Super Cup wins on 1 August, Xeka scoring the only goal to give his side their first victory in the competition. LOSC were runners-up in 1955 and 2011.

• On 16 July, LOSC captain José Fonte signed a new one-year contract until June 2022.

• Yusuf Yazıcı scored Turkey's second goal in a 2-2 home draw against Montenegro in 2022 FIFA World Cup qualifying on 1 September.

• Jonathan David scored in Canada's 3-0 win over El Salvador in World Cup qualifying on 8 September.

• Sven Botman captained the Netherlands' U21 side for the first time in a 3-0 win against Moldova in 2023 UEFA European Under-21 Championship qualifying on 7 September.

• Renato Sanches, who has not played since the opening day of the Ligue 1 season, underwent knee surgery in August while Jonathan Bamba and Timothy Weah both sat out the defeat at Lorient with thigh strains.

• Wolfsburg are the only team with maximum points after four Bundesliga games this season, winning 2-0 at Greuther Fürth on Saturday. Lukas Nmecha and Wout Weghorst secured the points with their second league goals of the season.

• A Weghorst goal gave Mark van Bommel's side a 1-0 victory at home to Bochum on 14 August.

• A week later Wolfsburg won 2-1 at Hertha Berlin, new signing Nmecha scoring the decisive late goal.

• On 29 August Jérôme Roussillon was on target in a 1-0 home win against Leipzig.

• Wolfsburg won 3-1 after extra time at Münster in the German Cup first round on 8 August, but a 2-0 win was subsequently awarded to the fourth division side due to a Wolfsburg substitution irregularity.

• Dodi Lukébakio and Koen Casteels both started Belgium's World Cup qualifier against Belarus in Kazan on 8

September, the former making his first competitive start in the 1-0 win and the latter keeping his first international clean sheet.

- Xaver Schlager has been out since the Leipzig game because of a knee injury, Kevin Mbabu returning as a substitute on Saturday having also suffered a knee problem against Leipzig.
- Paulo Otávio is yet to feature this season because of an ankle injury he suffered on 31 July.
- William is facing a long spell on the sidelines having suffered a knee injury on loan at Schalke at the beginning of May.
- Bartosz Białek has not played since 28 April because of a knee injury.
- Schlager, William and Białek have all been left out of Wolfsburg's UEFA Champions League squad.
